CONFLICT OF INTEREST

All officials must declare any interests which may conflict with their role as an On/Off Field Official at the FIL World Event or FIL Approved Event.

The applicant should list all interests that relate to their potential appointment as an On/Off Field Official. For example, their relationship to any team personnel or official (personally and professionally), any commercial or business operations, any other related parties (spouses, partners, children, brothers, sisters, parents, grandparents and step relationships that may impact on the assessment), any position they may hold on a National Governing Body.

Where a potential conflict of interest arises, this information will be referred in confidence to the FIL Women's Officiating Chair and FIL Technical Director for consultation to determine if the conflict requires further attention.

Applicants should immediately inform the FIL Officiating Chair of any changes occurring in their signed Conflict of Interest form. All information will be maintained confidentially by the FIL Officiating Chair.
